CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION and COMMUNICATION FROM THE ACTING CHAIRPERSON OF THE PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE relative to approving the withdrawal from public use the locations stated in the subject Motions.

Recommendations for Council action, as reviewed by the City Engineer:

1. FIND these projects are categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 pursuant to Article VII, Class 5(3) of the City's Environmental Guidelines.
2. ADOPT the following Motions proposing the withdrawal from public use of the following locations and subject to the conditions for withdrawal contained in each Motion:

90-1538 (Farrell-Lindsay) proposing the withdrawal of the alleys  
CD 8 south of 71st Street between Cimarron Street and St. Andrews Place, etc.

90-1826 (Lindsay-Flores) proposing withdrawal of the alley northerly  
CD 9 of 5th Street between Towne Avenue and Standford Avenue, etc.

90-1795 (Braude-Galanter) proposing withdrawal of the walk southerly  
CD 11 of the Santa Monica Freeway between Colby Avenue and Coolidge Avenue, etc.

90-1541 (Woo-Lindsay) proposing withdrawal of the walk northerly of  
CD 13 Sunset Boulevard between Westerly Terrace and Silverlake Boulevard, etc.

90-1090 (Alatorre-Flores) proposing withdrawal of the former fire  
CD 14 road between Range Road and Delevan Drive, etc.

The Motions recommended for approval by this report have been reviewed by the City Engineer who has determined that the required consent forms from adjoining property owners have been received.

M O T I O N

Mr. Edward Eghiaian of 1300 Westerly Terrace and the adjacent property owners have requested to close the walk northerly of Sunset Boulevard between Westerly Terrace and Silverlake Boulevard through the "Withdrawal from Public Use" Procedure to deter illegal dumping of trash and eliminate an unsanitary and unhealthful environment created by people using the walk to sleep at night and to trade or use illegal drugs.

If the walk is withdrawn from public use, all the adjoining property owners and/or residents retain all rights of access to it. The walk will be closed at no cost to the City, and keys to the locks on the gates will be provided to any adjoining property owner and/or resident requesting them.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the walk northerly of Sunset Boulevard between Westerly Terrace and Silverlake Boulevard be withdrawn from public use in accordance with Government Code Section 37359. This is similar to minor vacation and is categorically exempt under Article 7, Class 5(3), of the Los Angeles City California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines.

I FURTHER MOVE that the walk be permitted to be closed at the ends by gates approved by the City Engineer and providing further that the keys to locks on the gates be given to the adjacent property owners and/or residents, the Los Angeles Police and Fire Departments, Department of Public Works, and public utility companies, if requested.

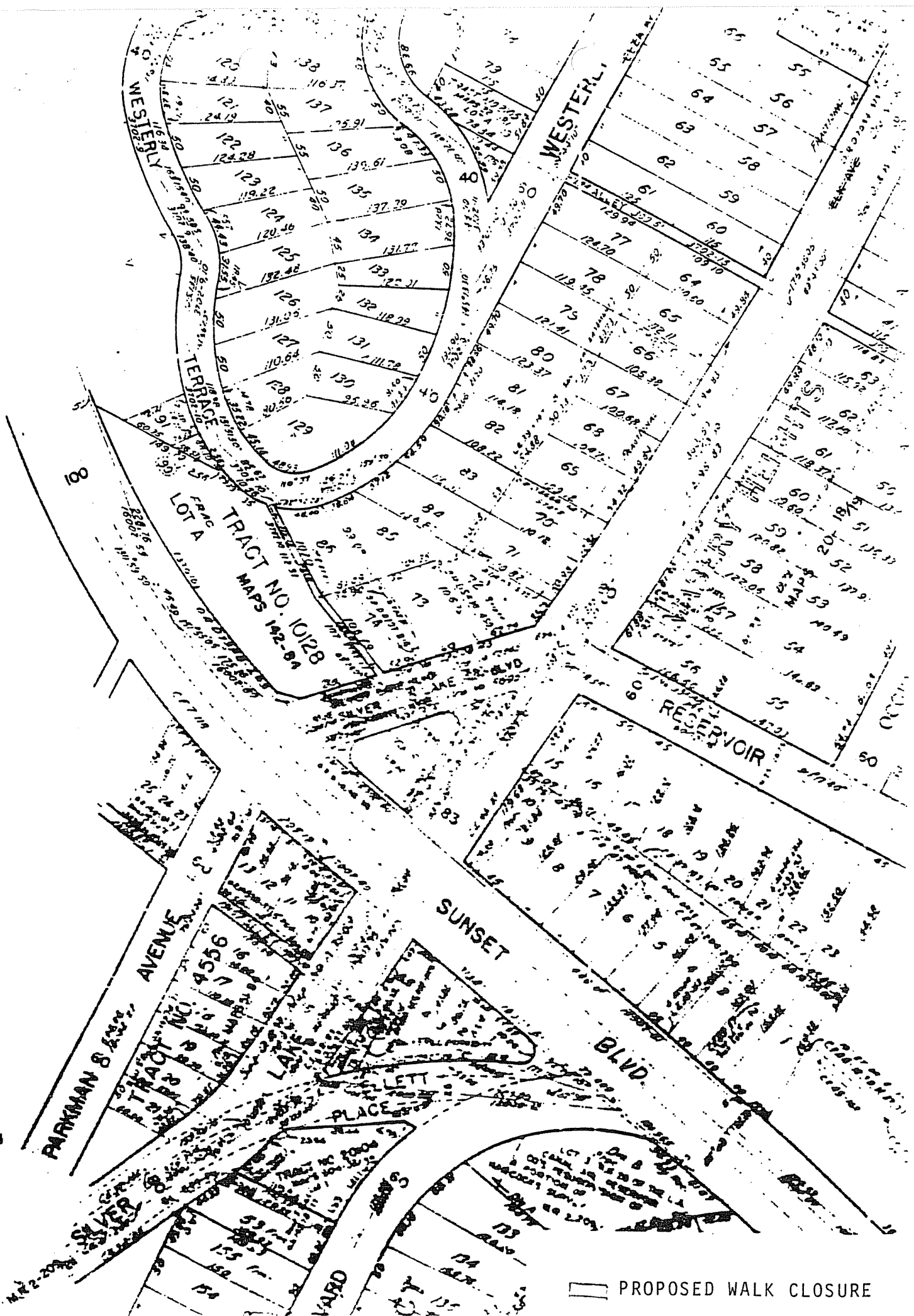
